



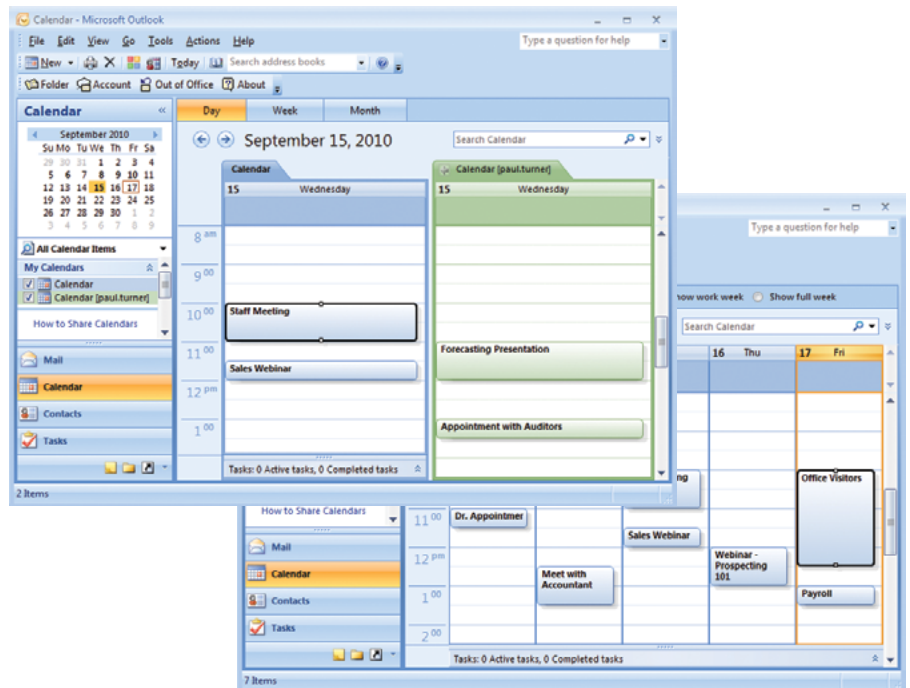
Outlook Connector for MDAemon

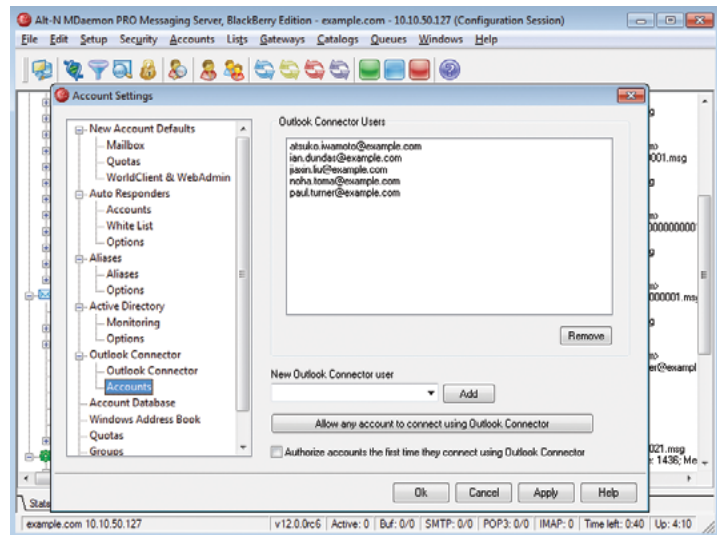
Calendar sharing is easy with Outlook Connector, with permissions ranging from view only to add, change, and delete appointments on others' calendars.

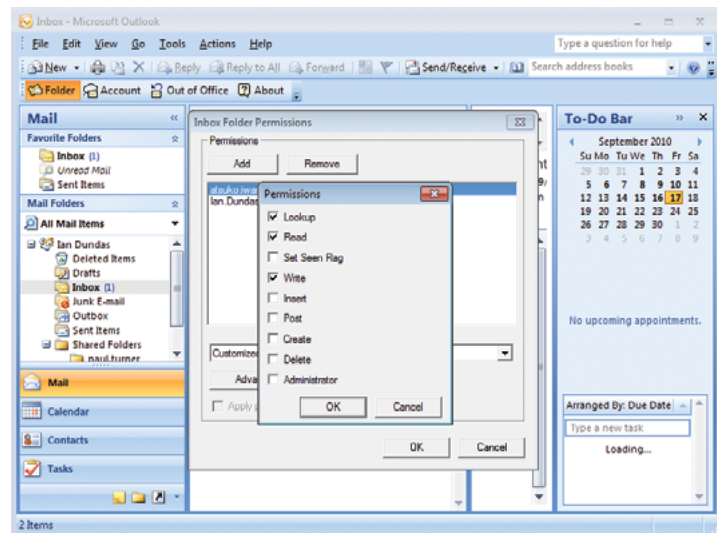

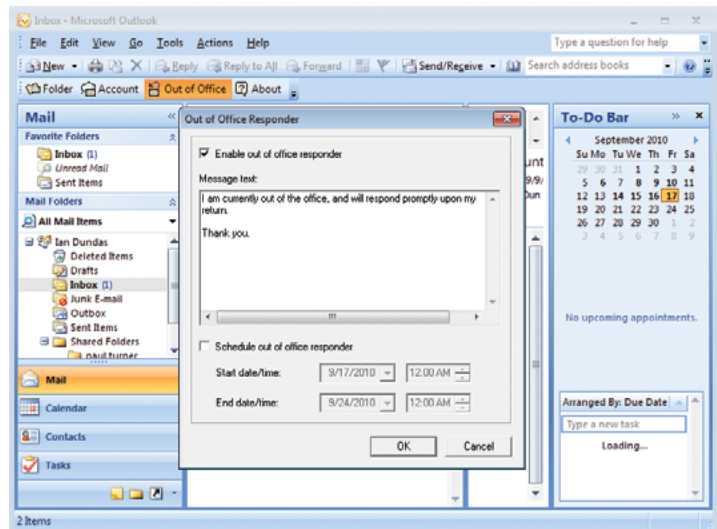
- MDAemon 9.0 or higher is recommended
